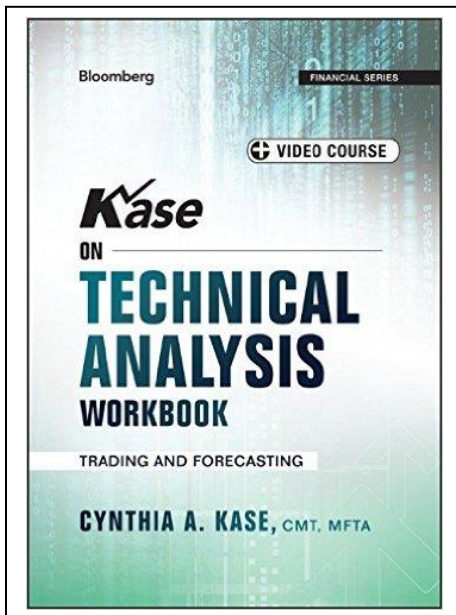

Book Review: Kase on Technical Analysis Workbook and Video Course; Trading and Forecasting by Cynthia A. Kase



Cynthia Kase's Video Course, Kase on Technical Analysis, Trading and Forecasting, is a thorough and well-presented one-stop training course on Technical Analysis that both a beginner to the subject, as well as an experienced Technician, can benefit from.

The Video Course is divided into 13 sections, including chart construction, trending indicators swing systems, chart patterns, candlesticks and gaps, using stops, bar patterns, momentum

indicators, forecasting techniques, developing a general market view, finishing up with multiple chart trading utilizing Kase Statware and KaseX. Each section is well-presented and easy to comprehend, particularly given the use of charts to explain each of the concepts being discussed.

The accompanying Workbook to the course is a valuable aid in helping the reader test their knowledge of the information gleaned from the video course. There is a comprehensive question section in the Workbook that reviews the material taught in the series of videos, as well as an answer section that walks the reader through each of the questions presented and provides well-presented and easily understood answers to each of the questions.

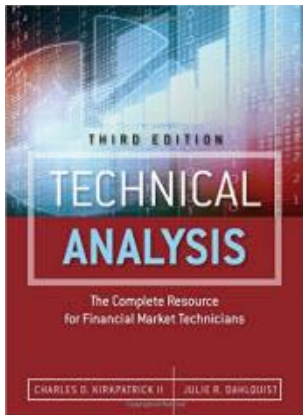
